National Wilderness Preservation System

The National Wilderness Preservation System currently contains 765 wilderness areas comprising 109,138,286 acres.

State Wilderness Systems

In addition to federally designated wilderness areas, seven states--Alaska, California, Maryland, Michigan, Missouri, New York, and Wisconsin--have state wilderness systems.

Tribal Wildernesses

Various Native American tribal bodies--including Montana's Confederated Salish and Kootenai and California's Inter-Tribal Sinkyone Wilderness Council--have designated tribal lands as wilderness.
