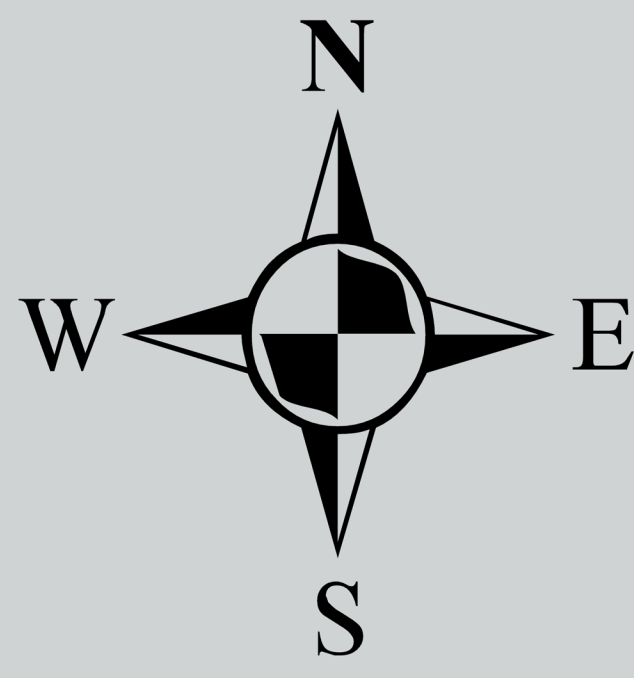





National Wilderness Preservation System

The Wilderness Act of 1964 established the NWPS, a network of federal public lands protected at the highest level to remain wild and natural for current and future generations. Today, the NWPS includes over 111 million acres in more than 800 wilderness areas across the United States and Puerto Rico, managed by the Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and U.S. Forest Service.
