Title: Resolution providing for the consideration of H.R. 30. A bill to establish the Hells Canyon National Recreation Area in the States of Oregon, Idaho, and Washington. **Sponsor:** Rep Young, John [TX-14] (introduced 11/18/1975) Cosponsors (None) **Related Bills:** H.R.30 **Latest Major Action:** 11/18/1975 Passed/agreed to in House. Status: Measure passed House.

SUMMARY AS OF: 11/18/1975--Introduced.

Provides that upon the adoption of this resolution it shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the Union for the consideration of the bill (H. R. 30) to establish the Hells Canyon National Recreation Area in the States of Oregon, Idaho, and Washington, and for other purposes. Directs that after general debate, which shall be confined to the bill and shall continue not to exceed one hour, to be equally divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs, the bill shall be read for amendment under the five-minute rule. Provides that it shall be in order to consider the amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs now printed in the bill as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule. Directs that, at the conclusion of such consideration, the Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with such amendments as may have been adopted, and any Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute. Provides that the previous question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without intervening motion except one motion to recommit with or without instructions. Directs that after the passage of H. R. 30, the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs shall be discharged from the further consideration of the bill S. 322, and it shall then be in order in the House to move to strike out all after the enacting clause of said Senate bill and insert in lieu thereof the provisions contained in H. R. 30 as passed by the House.
