- Authorized Officer shall, within 60 calendar days of receipt of a proposal, review the proposal and advise the proponent as to whether the Forest Service will accept the proposal as a formal application or deny the proposal based on initial or second-level screening.
- Return any proposal that fails one or more of the initial screening
 - o If proposal was submitted orally, response may be oral. If submitted in writing, a written explanation of the denial shall be sent.
 - o Returned proposal in initial screening is not subject to environmental analysis or administrative appeal.
- Authorized Officer shall notify proponent if proposal passes initial screening and is proceeding to second-level screening.
 - o Provide the proponent with: info concerning potential land use conflicts; processing timeframes; environmental & management concerns; administrative fees and anticipated land use rental; and approvals from other agencies, if required.
 - Identify any on-the-ground investigations required that may require a temporary permit.
 - o Present the kind of authorization and general terms and conditions that may be applicable to the use.
 - o Inform the proponent that they are responsible for providing studies or other documentation needed to complete the environmental analysis process and for costs incurred in obtaining that info.
 - Inform proponent that if a road easement is approved, they will be responsible for providing a recordable survey plat or exhibit of the ROW
