There are no outhouses in the Great Gulf Wilderness. Are you prepared to heed nature's call in a responsible fashion? One of the most popular ways is to use a trowel to dig a cathole 8 inches deep, make your deposit and then replace the soil. Toilet paper will break down with the buried waste but anything else must be packed out. Improper disposal of waste creates a health issue, diminishes Wilderness character and is punishable by fine. Please Leave No Trace.
